Sub: Application for starting a new un-aided private college (self-financing) viz. **Vaani College of Education, Chettiyappanur Village and Post, Vaniyambadi, Vellore District** - Provisional affiliation for 2008-2009 Granted - Regarding.

3. Letter dated 12.06.2008 along with the DD for Rupees 2.5 lakhs (DD.No.694445, dated 12.06.2008, State Bank of India, Vaniyambadi) received from the Secretary, **Vaani Educational Trust, Chettiyappanur Village and Post, Vaniyambadi.**

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I am, by direction, to inform you that the Syndicate at its meeting held on **09.06.2008** has considered your request to grant affiliation for starting a new un-aided private (Self-financing) College of Education in the name and style of "**Vaani College of Education, Chettiyappanur Village and Post, Vaniyambadi, Vellore District**" to offer B.Ed. Degree Course for the

academic year 2008-2009 with the students strength of 100, based on (a) the recognition from the NCTE; and (b) the report of Inspection commission sent by this University, and resolved to grant provisional affiliation for the academic year 2008-2009, subject to fulfillment of the following conditions.

1. Conditions stipulated by the Inspection Commission in its report after inspection [copy enclosed]
2. All the conditions laid down by the NCTE, Bangalore
3. Other usual conditions of affiliation [copy enclosed]
4. Candidates to be admitted in B.Ed. Degree course should (a) satisfy the eligibility conditions prescribed in the Regulations (b) obtain eligibility certificate from the University and (c) earn required attendance prescribed by the University for appearing for the University Examinations.
5. The teachers should be paid salary as per the pay scales of UGC and their salaries should be paid through Bank, by name Cheque only;
6. The Syllabus prescribed by the Thiruvalluvar University to be followed from the academic year 2007-2008 onwards.

The conditions laid down by this University for affiliation are enclosed which the College should strictly adhere to and any lapse will attract penal action under the Laws of the University of Madras under Chapter XXVI of the University Calendar, Volume I, 2001 which is applicable to this University.

While communicating the above decision, I am to request you to kindly forward a specific and detailed report in this regard, immediately after fulfilling all the above conditions of affiliation.

I am also to inform you that fresh admissions should not be made in the above course during the next academic year 2009-2010 under any circumstances and until the University grants continuation of provisional affiliation for 2009-2010. It may be noted that the provisional affiliation now granted for 2008-2009, as per Statute 44-A of Chapter XXVI of the Laws of the Madras University Calendar Volume I, 2001, for the above said course will

cease automatically and will not be extended for the next academic year [i.e. 2009-2010].

You should apply for continuation of affiliation for the academic year 2009-2010 on or before 31.03.2009, along with processing fee of Rs.5,000/- in the form of DD in favour of the Registrar, Thiruvalluvar University.

## CONDITIONS OF AFFILIATION

1. Arrangement shall be made by the college for the conduct of University Examinations.
2. No donations shall be collected from the students seeking admission to any course of study in the college.
3. **Excess admission shall never be** made to any course over and above the sanctioned strength of the respective course(s).
4. The Management of College shall not discontinue any existing course without prior permission from the University which should be intimated before the 30<sup>th</sup> September.
5. The college shall only collect Tuition and other fees from the students at the rates as prescribed by the State Government / University.
6. The College should have [1] Separate lounge [2] Rest room [3] Toilet [4] Women Faculty Etc
7. A Librarian, Physical Director/Directress and a Medical officer with the prescribed qualification shall be appointed.
8. Number of teaching and non-teaching staff shall be appointed as per norms prescribed by the University/ U.G.C./ NCTE / Government for each course.
9. No teacher shall be appointed, if he/ she has not fulfilled the qualifications as laid down by the University and U.G.C./NCTE from time to time.
10. Teaching and Non-teaching staff shall be paid as per pay scales of State Government / U.G.C./NCTE prescribed from time to time.
11. An agreement shall be entered into with each teacher to be appointed as per the requirements of the University/ Tamilnadu Private Colleges [Regulation]. Act and rules thereunder.
12. The College shall implement each and every one of the recommendations of the Inspection commission.
13. The classrooms shall be according to the suggested U.G.C./NCTE norms.
14. The library should be strengthened, as suggested by the Inspection commission. The library shall have common reading room and stack room as per standard prescribed by the U.G.C. /NCTE/ Government.
15. The teacher should be paid as per pay scales of UGC/AICTE/NCTE/Vth pay commission of the State Government, as the case may be, and their salary should be paid through Banks, by means of Cheques. This will be verified by the authorities from time to time.

16. The maximum number of students who may be admitted to each of the course shall not exceed the strength sanctioned by the University.
17. Laboratory shall be strengthened, as suggested by the Commission. The Laboratory shall have sufficient equipments required for performing experiments prescribed for the courses of study. The laboratories shall also have adequate arrangement for gas supply, regular water supply and electricity. The safety standard shall be fully observed.
18. Necessary Hostel accommodation, Staff quarters, Play ground are to be provided.
19. The posts of teacher and Head of the Departments wherever required for the proposed course shall be filled up before starting the course.
20. No teacher shall be appointed or shall be continued in service, who has attained the age of superannuation as may be prescribed by the Tamilnadu Government.
21. Suitable leave rules for teaching and Non-teaching staff be framed, generally in conformity with the State Government rules.
22. Approval shall be obtained from the University before appointing the teaching staff.
23. All conditions of affiliation laid down in Chapter XXVI Laws of the Madras University Calendar, Volume-I 2001 as amended shall be strictly followed.
24. Such other Rules and Regulations as may be generally prescribed from time to time by the University shall also be complied with.
25. If all the conditions of Provisional affiliation granted are not complied with by the end of the period fixed then affiliation or approval shall cease automatically.
26. The College should obtain planning permission and Building Permit from the competent authorities for constructions.

**The Management / Principal is instructed to strictly follow the guidelines and other procedures regarding**

1. Educational qualifications and marks prescribed for the candidates.
2. To follow the guidelines prescribed by the Director of Collegiate Education from time to time with regard to age limit, Reservation rules and percentage of seats among optional subjects.
3. Working days prescribed.

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16. The number of students who may be admitted to each of the courses shall not exceed the strength sanctioned to the University.

17. Lecturers shall be appointed as suggested by the Commission. The University shall have sufficient equipment, material for practical experiments prescribed for the course of study. The University shall also have adequate arrangement for gas supply, water supply and electricity. The safety standard shall be fully observed.

18. Necessary Hostel accommodation, staff quarters, play ground etc. shall be provided.

19. The posts of teacher and head of the department wherever required for the proposed course shall be filled up before starting the course.

20. A teacher shall be appointed or shall be continued in service who has attained the age of superannuation as may be prescribed by the Government.

21. Suitable laws rules for teaching and non-teaching staff be framed generally in conformity with the State Government rules.

22. Approval shall be obtained from the University before appointing the teaching staff.

23. All conditions of appointment laid down in Chapter XXVI law of the Madras University (Amendment) 2001 as amended shall be strictly followed.

24. Such other rules and regulations as may be generally prescribed from time to time by the University shall also be complied with.

25. If all the conditions of provisional affiliation granted are not complied with by the end of the period fixed then affiliation or approval shall cease automatically.

26. The College should obtain planning permission and building permit from the competent authorities for construction.
